

“मंथन – New India Initiative” | Faridabad Vision 2022 Framework Document

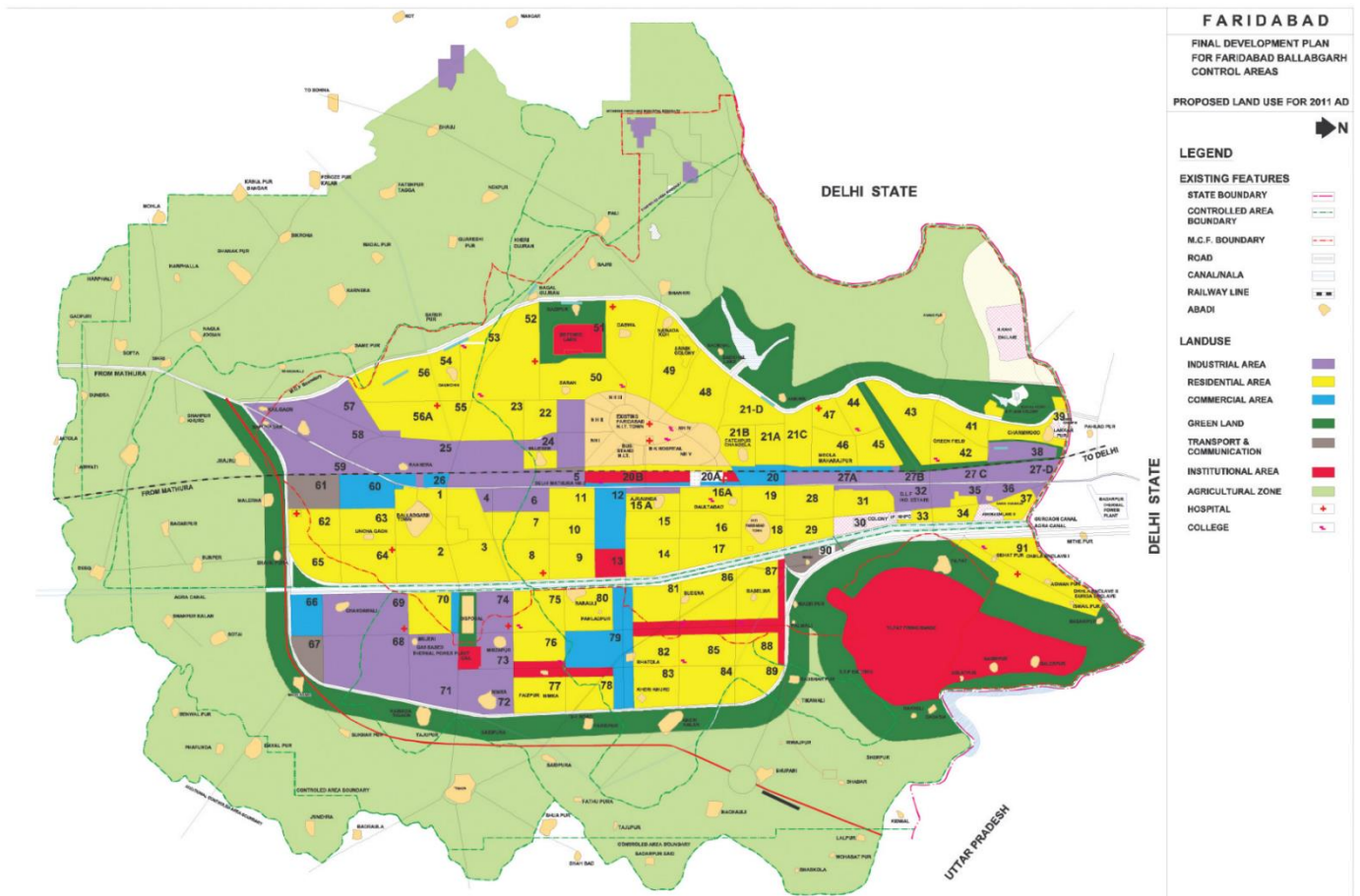
Introduction:

Honorable Prime Minister, Sh. Narendra Modi addressed District Collectors across the country via video-conference on the theme of “New India – Manthan”, on 9th August. It was launched on the 75th anniversary of Quit India movement with first-of-its-kind interaction with district collectors. The program is aimed at galvanizing public opinion to ignite the movement of nation building with the slogan of “संकल्प से सिद्धि”. The Prime Minister has appealed to every individual, each family and organisations to set goals to be reached by 2022 while stressing upon the role of District Collectors in the movement and emphasized that District Collectors will have to decide where they want to see their districts in that year.

Taking inspiration from the idea and to contribute our most, district Faridabad also commits to working in a more organized and a systemic way by further adopting innovative “संकल्प” and preparing a road map to achieve them by 2022. Faridabad firmly believes in holistic growth across sectors and sustainable development of the district – these principles also has laid the foundation of this document.

This document is a framework of how district Faridabad sees different sectors evolving by 2022 and is an outline as to how would the district look like 5 years down the line. We have set clear and measurable goals across different sectors to achieve this holistic development. These points were arrived at through regular feedback from public, social organisations, elected representatives and scholars at various meetings and gatherings.

Faridabad District – Profile:



Faridabad is one of the **leading industrial centers** situated in the National Capital Region bordering the Indian capital New Delhi. Located 284 kilometers south of the state capital Chandigarh, it is the **most populous city** in the state of Haryana. The river Yamuna forms the eastern district boundary with Uttar Pradesh. The district having an approximate area of 742.90 Sq.Km. accommodates a **population of about 25 lakhs**. Almost 80% population of the District is urbanized. Government of India has also included Faridabad in the second list of **Smart Cities Mission** on 24 May 2016.

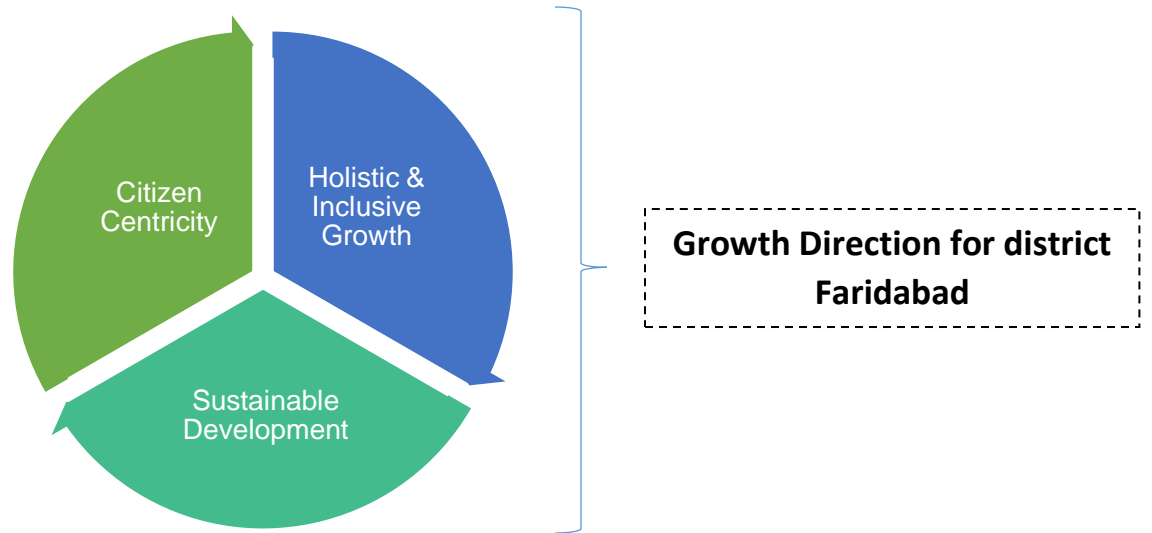
The newly developed residential and industrial part of Faridabad the Agra Canal and the Yamuna River is commonly referred as **Greater Faridabad**. The area is being developed as a self-sustained sub-city with wide roads, tall buildings, malls, educational institutions, and health and commercial and industrial centres.

Faridabad is also a major industrial hub of Haryana. Faridabad is famous for henna production from the agricultural sector, while tractors, motorcycles, switch gears, refrigerators, shoes, tires and garments constitute its primary industrial products. There are now about **15,000 small, medium and large industries** in this industrial corridor providing direct and indirect employment to nearly half a million people and ranks 9th largest industrial estate in India. The combined turnover is estimated to be about **Rs. 100 Million**. Many multinational companies like JCB, Yamaha Motors, Whirlpool, Goodyear, Larsen & Toubro, Asia Brown Boveri, GKN Invel, Woodward Governor, and Castrol besides Escorts, Eicher, Cutler Hammer, Hyderabad Asbestos, and Nuchem are operating in this belt.

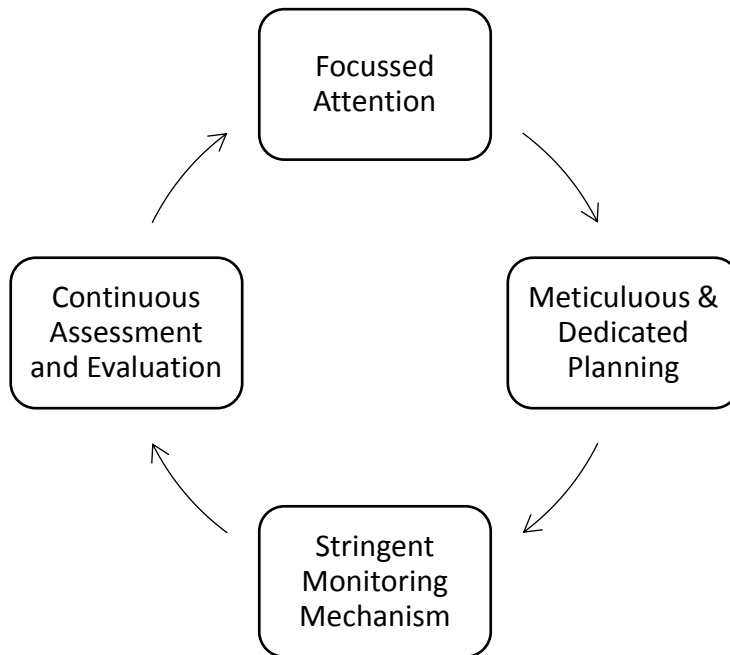
